Freeport Community Library (FCL) is funded wholly by Freeport taxpayers. Freeport residents, property owners, and employees of the Town of Freeport are eligible for free library cards with proof of residence/ownership/employment. Residents of other towns may purchase an annual membership. Non-resident family cards cost \$55 per year or \$30 for 6 months.

Important information about your card:

- You can check out items from our library's collection and interlibrary loans through the Minerva and MaineCat systems.
- You can accrue overdue fines of 10¢ per item per day (fines cap at \$1.50 per item) and replacement fees for lost or damaged items.
- If fines and/or fees on your card reach \$10, the card cannot be used until fines are paid.
- If you lose your card, you can replace it for \$1.
- The Library will not disclose information about a child's card to a parent or guardian without permission from the child.
