Freeport Community Library (FCL) is funded wholly by Freeport taxpayers. Freeport residents, property owners, and employees of the Town of Freeport are eligible for free library cards with proof of residence/ownership/employment. Residents of other towns may purchase an annual membership. Non-resident family cards cost \$60 per year, \$30 for 6 months or \$15 for 3 months.

Important information about your card:

- You can check out items from our library's collection and interlibrary loans through the Minerva and MaineCat systems.
- You can accrue replacement fees for lost or damaged items.
- If replacement fees are added, the card cannot be used until the fees are paid.
- The Library will not disclose information about a child's card to a parent or guardian without permission from the child.
- For the safety of all children who visit the library, children under age 8 must be accompanied and directly supervised by a responsible caregiver age 11 and up, who assumes full accountability for the children's safety and behavior in the library.
