Freeport Community Library (FCL) is funded wholly by Freeport taxpayers. The town and school budgets are separate budgets. At present, FCL permits children who are not Freeport residents but who currently attend one of the Freeport or South Freeport K-12 schools listed above to have a free FCL non-resident student card for their own personal use. **This privilege does not extend to their parents or other family members.** Non-resident family cards cost \$60 per year, \$30 for 6 months or \$15 for 3 months.

Student Cards:

- May only be used by the student to check out materials from our library's collection
- Cannot be used for any interlibrary loans.
- You can accrue overdue replacement fees for lost or damaged items.
- If replacement fees are added, the card cannot be used until fees are paid.
- For the safety of all children who visit the library, children under age 8 must be accompanied and directly supervised by a responsible caregiver age 11 and up, who assumes full accountability for the children's safety and behavior in the library.

A parent/guardian must complete the section below in order to issue library card to student:
