Kids who can't read on their own qualify as Family Readers, and while they can't submit raffle tickets, families get a special reading log. FCL's StoryWalks and Virtual Storytime with Taylor on Youtube count as read books!

## Who can earn raffle tickets?



### **Independent Readers**

- Who can participate?* Any child reading independently through outgoing 8th graders.
- Readers must keep track of the titles they read.
- Use the Tails and Tales reading log to write down what you've read.
- Readers must read 3 books before submitting a raffle ticket, and will need to submit a new raffle ticket for every 3 books they read.
- Remember audio books, magazines, and comic books all count!



### **Teen Readers**

- Who can participate?* Incoming 6th graders through outgoing 8th graders.
- All teens have the choice between the Independent Reader and the Teen Reader programs.
- Readers must read 1 book before submitting a raffle ticket.
- Readers will need to submit a new raffle ticket for every book they read.
- Remember audio books, magazines, and comic books all count!



### **Bedtime Math**

- Who can participate?* All children through outgoing 8th graders.
- Participants must attempt 3 math problems at [bedtimemath.org](http://bedtimemath.org) before submitting your raffle ticket.
- Participants will need to submit a new raffle ticket for every 3 problems they try.
- The answer does NOT need to be correct for it to count. You just have to try!

## How can I submit raffle tickets?

### Online

1. Go to [freeportlibrary.com](http://freeportlibrary.com).
2. Click on Kids tab.
3. Select Kids Programs from the drop down menu.
4. Click on the image tile of the program you are checking in for
5. Complete the Google form.

### By Phone

1. Call the Library at 865-3307 during our open hours.
2. Select 2 to talk to Youth Services.
3. We will fill out the Google form for you while you are on the phone.



### **Family Readers**

- *Who can participate?* Any child not reading on their own.
- Even though they can't submit raffle tickets, families get their own special reading log.

## **Important Dates and Info**

- June 1, 2021: You can start tracking your reading and math!
- June 7, 2021: First day you can submit a raffle ticket
- August 5, 2021: SMRP ends at 5:00 pm
- August 6, 2021: Raffle winners will be called
- Prizes must be picked up by September 3, 2021 at 5:00 pm

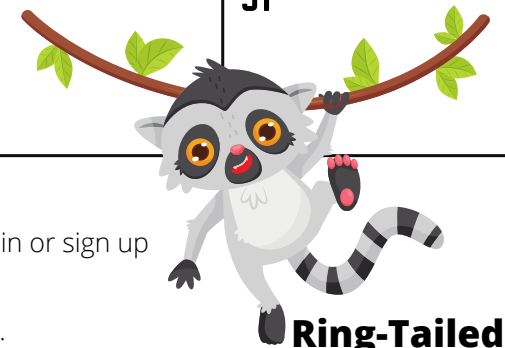

**Storytime with Taylor:** Sometimes funny, sometimes heartwarming, always under 20 minutes. Each video link is on our events calendar.

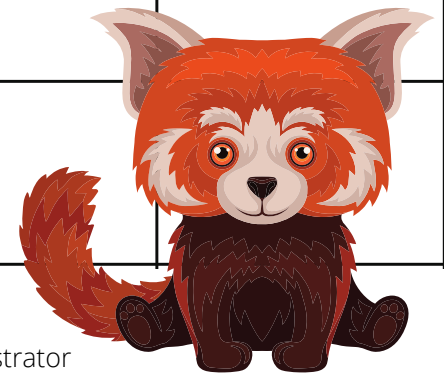
