



Lending Policy

Guidelines for Borrowing and Use

Objects lent out by Freeport Community Library through its Library of Things program must be checked out from and returned to Freeport Community Library in Freeport, ME - **do not return Things in a book drop**. A valid Freeport Community Library card in good standing is required to borrow a Thing. Borrowers must be at least 18 years old. Courtesy Teacher and Student cards are not eligible for checking out a Thing. At this time only Freeport Community Library patrons can reserve a Thing.

Loan Periods and Fines

In most cases, a Thing may be borrowed for 3 week intervals and cannot be renewed. WiFi Hotspot kits may be borrowed for 7 days and cannot be renewed.

Proper Use and Liability

Use care when handling the Thing. The borrower is solely responsible for the Thing and will be billed for reasonable repair or replacement costs associated with damage or loss of Things and/or peripherals due to neglect or abuse. The Library has sole discretion in making these decisions. Freeport Community Library is not responsible for any injury, loss, or damage that may occur from use of a Thing.
